



Sea Org members leave in order to

There's this expression "blow", the sudden departure from a spot, a session, work or area.

Those who left CoS may hear that they "blew" so that they would no longer do damage.

And this would be fairly accurate.

In the CoS case you could, watching closely, see how CoS itself is blowing itself off from the dynamics. See it in statistics but it's more obvious looking at the supporters dropping away.

In reality this is about the S.O.

*The S.O. Is on its way out, away from life. You
can see it in the individuals dropping away from
it.*

- An individual doesn't want to be part of crimes against human rights
- A S.O. Member doesn't want to do some of the things he's asked to do right now

To put his ethics in, the S.O. Member blows.

The remaining S.O. wants to make it look like a blow from the S.O. caused by transgressions against the group. There may be a few of these but this is a very narrow way of looking at it.

The S.O. Member is leaving so that he can stop damaging his *dynamics*.

"I SAW WHAT WAS HAPPENING AND I WAS ASHAMED."

"I COULDN'T UNDERSTAND WHY NOBODY TOOK ACTION TO STOP IT!"

was unacceptable.
